1. Important Notes:

- 1. Applications of such candidates, who have not submitted their final result by **22-12-2020**, have not been considered, as obtaining merit on the basis of final aggregate %age of qualifying examination was not possible.
- 2. NIMCET Qualified candidates shall be given preference over the GGSIPU CET qualified candidates. Counselling shall first be conducted to fill up seats based upon the Merit List of the NIMCET qualified candidates, after which the vacant seats shall be filled based upon the Merit List of the GGSIPU CET qualified candidate.
- 3. Candidates are advised in their own interest to report the mistakes / discrepancies, if any, in this merit list, to the Director of the Institute in writing or by E-Mail at mca@bvicam.ac.in, latest by 24-12-2020 upto 02:00 p.m.
- 4. On account of the delay in the admission process, it has been observed that the overall response of the aspiring candidates for admission in the Management Category is very poor and only limited number of candidates have applied by the last date, which was 22-12-2020. Further, no candidate of any of the Reserved Categories (SC/ST/Def./PwD) has applied. In view of this and considering the larger interest of the aspiring candidates, such candidates of Reserved Categories (SC/ST/Def./PwD) and General Category, who are still desirous of taking admission in the Management Category and could not apply by the last date, can also apply latest by 26-12-2020 upto 11:30 a.m. or directly report on the spot latest by 26-12-2020 upto 11:30 a.m. along with all the required documents and fill the required application for admission against the vacant seats (if any) in the Management Category. However, their candidature shall be considered for admission in the Management Category, only if the Merit List displayed above is exhausted and the seats remain vacant. For this, a Supplementary Merit List of all such candidates, having reported on the Spot and/or applied till 26-12-2020, shall be prepared on the spot and the same shall be used for admission against vacant seats (if any), during Spot Counselling on 26-12-2020 at 02:30 p.m., on Merit, only after exhausting the Merit List already displayed above.
- 5. The given list is provisional subject to the verification of obtained marks from the final result and other details of candidates with reference to the documentary evidence for his / her eligibility, as required under the rules of GGSIP University, New Delhi. If any discrepancy is found during the verification of the documents at the time of the admission, before allotment of the seat, the Merit List may change, and in that case, the admission will be carried based upon the revised Merit List.
- 6. Invitation for Counselling does not guarantee any admission. Please note that the Counselling / Admission shall continue till the vacancy remains and shall be stopped as and when the seats are filled up.

- 7. Candidates shall attend Counselling on their own expenses, in all respects, after confirming their own Eligibility as mentioned in the Admission Brochure and subsequent Notification of the University for the Academic Year 2020-2021. Candidates must also check the University Website for the list of documents required at the time of the counselling.
- 8. The allotment of seats to the candidates will be made only when they attend the counselling session, in person, along with all the required original documents along with two sets of photocopies, as listed out at the University Website, 05 latest colour photographs and the total fees of the Institute in form of Demand Draft / Cheque / Online Transfer / NetBanking / NEFT / RTGS/IMPS/etc. Please note that in absence of any of the documents / fee, at the time of Counselling, the claim to the seat allotment shall stand cancelled.
- 9. Candidates under "NOT ADMITTED" Category only shall be considered for admission against 10% Management Quota Seats. It may further be noted that a candidate, who has taken admission at any other Institute of the GGSIP University, New Delhi, under MCA Programme in 2020-2021, is NOT ELIGIBLE, as she / he shall be considered as ADMITTED STUDENT.

2. Counselling Schedule & Venue:

The Counselling of the Institute for admission against 10% Management Quota Seats, as approved by GGSIP University, New Delhi, shall be held on 26-12-2020 (The Saturday) at 10:00 a.m. (sharp). Reporting of candidates and document verification shall start at 09:00 a.m. Candidates are advised to report in advance, so that the document verification can be completed upto 10:00 a.m. Successful document verification and eligibility confirmation is must for participation in the Counselling for Seat Allotment. Late Comers will be allowed for the remaining vacancies (if any), only after exhausting the candidates, having completed the document verification upto 10:00 a.m. (sharp). Counselling will continue until all the Vacant Seats are filled. The Venue of the Counselling is Delphi Hall, Ground Floor, E-Block, BVICAM, A-4, Paschim Vihar, Adjacent to Paschim Vihar (East) Metro Station, Rohtak Road, New Delhi-110063.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

As notified by the GGSIP University, New Delhi. For reference, the GGSIPU Notification No.: GGSIPU / DAA / 2020 / 2912 dated 30-07-2020 and other subsequent notifications, may please be referred.
