5. Candidates shall attend Counselling on their own expenses, in all respects, after confirming their own Eligibility as mentioned in the Admission Brochure of the University. Candidates must also check the University Website for the list of documents required at the time of the counselling.

The allotment of seats to the candidates will be made only when they attend the counselling session, in person, along with all the required original documents along with two sets of photocopies, as listed out at the University Website, 05 latest colour photographs and the total fees of the Institute in form of Demand Draft / Cheque. Please note that in absence of any of the documents / fee, at the time of Counselling, the claim to the seat allotment shall stand cancelled.
7. **Candidates under "NOT ADMITTED" Category only shall be considered for admission against 10% Management Quota Seats. It may further be noted that a candidate, who has taken admission at any other Institute of the GGSIP University, New Delhi, under MCA Programme in 2017-2018, is NOT ELIGIBLE, as she / he shall be considered as ADMITTED STUDENT.**

2. Counselling Schedule:

The Counselling of the Institute for admission against 10% Management Quota Seats, as approved by GGSIP University, New Delhi, shall be held on **02nd August, 2017** at **10:00 a.m. (sharp)**. **Reporting of candidates and document verification shall start at 09:00 a.m.** Candidates are advised to report in advance, so that the document verification can be completed upto **10:00 a.m.** **Successful document verification is must for participation in the Counselling and eligibility for Seat Allotment. Late Comers will be allowed for the remaining vacancies (if any), only after exhausting the candidates, having completed the document verification upto 10:00 a.m. (sharp).** Counselling will continue until all the Vacant Seats are filled.
