Sub: Observance of Vigilance Awareness Week, 2019.

Madam/Sir,

As you are aware that the Central Vigilance Commission, the apex integrity institution of the country observes Vigilance Awareness Week every year and also advises all Ministries/Departments/ PSEs/Public Sector Banks/ Insurance Companies/Autonomous Organisations/Societies to observe the same. This year the CVC has decided to observe the Vigilance Awareness Week from 28th October to 2nd November. 2019 with the theme "Integrity -A way of life" (ইমানহামী- তুক জীৱন হান্টা)and issued circular No. 05/08/2019 dated 02/08/2019 (copy enclosed). You are therefore, requested to adhere to the following points while observing. Vigilance Awareness Week in your University and affiliated Colleges/Institution:

- a) The Vigilance Awareness Week should commence with Integrity Piedge to all the faculties, students and staff members by the senior most functionary on 28th October, 2019 at 11.00 A.M. A copy of the piedge is enclosed as Annexure-A to the CVC circular dated 02:08:2019
- b) The activities relevant to the theme [Integrity A way of life (ईमानदारी- एक जीवन रौती) as illustrated below, may be conducted within the University/Colleges/Institution:-
  - E-pledge of all faculty, staff and their family members and students by visiting CVC website.
  - Conduct of workshop/sensitization programme on policies and procedures with focus on Preventive measures, Academic Integrity, Ethical Practices in Admission, Finance and Accounts, Examination, Evaluation, Results and Research and Publications.
  - Conduct of various competitions viz debates, quiz, panel discussion, essay writing, slogan and poster competitions, walkathons, cyclathons.
  - Bringing out special issue of journals/news letters on systematic improvements and good practices adopted.
  - v. Encouraging the establishment of Integrity Clubs in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions so that the ethical values practiced through conducted activities are ingrained permanently in minds of younger generation.

- Outreach activities as shown below may be undertaken to sensitize the evil effect of corruption and its prevention in the society:-
  - Organizing human chain, conducting marathons, street plays etc. which have visibility and mass appeal on general public.
  - Display of hoardings, banners, posters and distribution of handouts at prominent locations.
  - Organizing grievance redressal camps for citizens/vendors/suppliers/ parents/students.
  - Publicizing and promoting the integrity pledge amongst citizens/vendors/ suppliers/parents/students and family members of the faculty and staff.
  - "Awareness Gram Sabha" he planned by all the Universities colleges institutions in nearby villages as a part of pace setting activity.
  - The parents and eminent persons of the locality should be invited to participate various programmes conducted by the University/College during the Vices Awareness Week. They should be made aware of:-
    - The aims and objectives of University/College schemes
    - The Admission policy.
    - The services rendered by the University College Institution in the field of education, cultural development, national integration, co-curricular & extracurricular activities.
    - The facilities provided to the students.
    - The role of various committees involved in the management affairs of the University/College.
    - process The transparency observed in the procurement University/college/ institution.
    - The students should be encouraged to participate in debates on anticorruption topics and in cultural programmes conveying the message of evils of corruption in the society
- In Universities/College, where the vacation break is scheduled, the students we a may be leaving for vacation break may be directed to spread the awareness message in rural areas.
- You are requested to organise the Vigilance Awareness Week in your University and affiliated colleges in a befitting manner and submit/upload the report along with photographs on the UGC University Activity Monitoring Portal (https://www.agc.ac.in/aaoup.) and also send the report in vigilance.ugc100/a/gmail.com in the prescribed format latest by 10th November, 2019 positively to enable UGC send a consolidated report to CVC.
